RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ACT 768,  
WHICH ALLOWS THE FORMER LOUISIANA SUPREME COURT SITE  
AND 325 LOYOLA AVENUE TO BE UTILIZED AS  
THE ORLEANS PARISH CIVIL DISTRICT COURT SITE AND A MUNICIPAL COMPLEX
